SHOULD I REPORT TO SCHOOL?

Have you tested **POSITIVE** for COVID-19?

NO, I have not.

Have you been in contact with someone who is probable positive or has tested **POSITIVE** for COVID-19?

NO, I have not.

Do you have any COVID-19 symptoms?

YES, I have.

YES, I have.

YES, I do.

NO, I do not.

Quarantine for 10 days from the first date of symptoms OR 10 days from your test date.

Were you within 6 feet of a probable/positive case for 15 or more cumulative minutes in a 24 hour period or in a classroom?

YES, I was.

Stay at home and monitor your symptoms. Self-isolate for 10 days since symptoms first began. **Contact your healthcare provider for evaluation and testing. Notify your school nurse.**

Report to school.

You may return to school with a note from your doctor when you are symptom-free.

Close contacts of an individual with COVID-19 compatible symptoms will be excluded through 14 days from date of last contact or until ill individual tests negative for COVID-19.

You may return to school with a note from your doctor when you are symptom-free.

A negative test is not required to return to school.

Notify your school nurse if you develop symptoms AND contact your healthcare provider for evaluation.

AND
A negative test is required to return to school.

You may return to school after 14 days without a doctor's note only if no symptoms develop.
