The Wyckoff Environmental Commission (WEC) and Wyckoff Green Team (WGT) participate in the Sustainable Jersey program. The points-based certification program guides municipalities on green initiatives and Wyckoff has accumulated 350 points to earn Silver Certification since 2011. Our Certification expires in December 2019 so we must resubmit by June 2019.

We are excited for our recertification work over the next six months as we get to partner with our schools and businesses on green initiatives.

We are hoping to work with the Wyckoff schools on an Anti-Idling Campaign, to improve air quality and create a healthier environment for our students, parents, teachers, staff and all Wyckoff residents.
