Context

- Each school Safety Team must self-assess its implementation of the ABR
- Districts must provide opportunity for the public to comment prior to BOE approval
- Due date for submitting self-assessments to the State of NJ is September 30, 2016
- School grades and district grade must be posted online within 10 days of receipt from the State

Self-assessment Rating Scale

3 = Exceeds All Requirements

2 = Meets All Requirements

1 = Partially Meets All Requirements

0 = Does Not Meet Requirements

- 68 (out of a possible 78) for each school
 - Coolidge Elementary School
 - Lincoln Elementary School
 - Sicomac Elementary School
 - Washington Elementary School
 - Eisenhower Middle School
- Score remained consistent in comparison to 2014-2015 Self-Assessment Report

Conclusion

- Each School Safety Team had a lead role in completing the Self-Assessment
- The district enjoys notable continuity in its implementation of the ABR
- No ratings of Partially Proficient or Does Not Meet Requirements
- School level HIB investigation and district reporting procedures exceed requirements
- Goal: Enhance trainings and assessments to continue improvement in school climate
